## 'Punk in Africa'



**What:** Don't miss this chronicle of the southern African hardcore scene. *Anarchy in the S-A!*

**Why:** This 2012 documentary chronicles a little-known chapter in the history of punk music—the southern African hardcore scene, which was banned and forced underground during the apartheid years.
