Another Camp Blood: First Slaughter

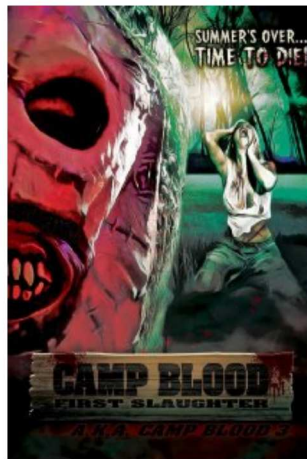

It doesn't seem to get any campier than this. Fresh on the film market circuit comes *Camp Blood: First Slaughter* and it looks like it has everything you could want in a cheesy slasher film. Coming to us from **TomCat Films**, this flick is the third installment in this horror series. Anyone see the first two? No really, I'm asking.

Here's the skinny on this campy film:

The infamous Camp Blood is open for business, and this time there may be more than one killer drenching the hills red with death! A college assignment sends a group of young students deep into the woods, and deeper into terror, as one by one, a masked killer begins to murder them in gruesome fashion. They say the 3rd time is the charm, and Camp Blood 3 has thrice the slice! Stay out of the woods unless you want to be the next victim of the Camp Blood killer.



At first, I was wondering where this fits in the Camp Blood series as I heard its a must in the slasher movie universe. Apparently, after doing the research, there was already a Camp Blood 3 and this one claims to be a third installment of the series as well. I'll leave the more over-arching questions for this title around if it is or isn't the real third installment for those who have seen the first *Camp Blood: Within The Woods*.

Here is a review from **DVD Verdict**:

What all this should indicate is that Camp Blood: First Slaughter is a busy film. It has a lot of "plot" and tries to both tell its own camp story while also tying up the "Camp Blood" franchise...I do kind of admire Camp Blood: First Slaughter for at least trying something new. Though the film's style often comes off as desperate rather than interesting, at least they tried something different. And, I have to say that if you sit through the first 65 or so minutes of the film you'll be treated to a plot twist that, while not novel, does do a surprisingly good job of tying up the film and connecting it to the wider Camp Blood franchise. Camp Blood: First Slaughter is yet another microbudget camp slasher film. Those who were clamoring for a sequel to the first two Camp Blood films might enjoy the direction this one takes.

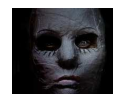

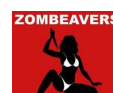

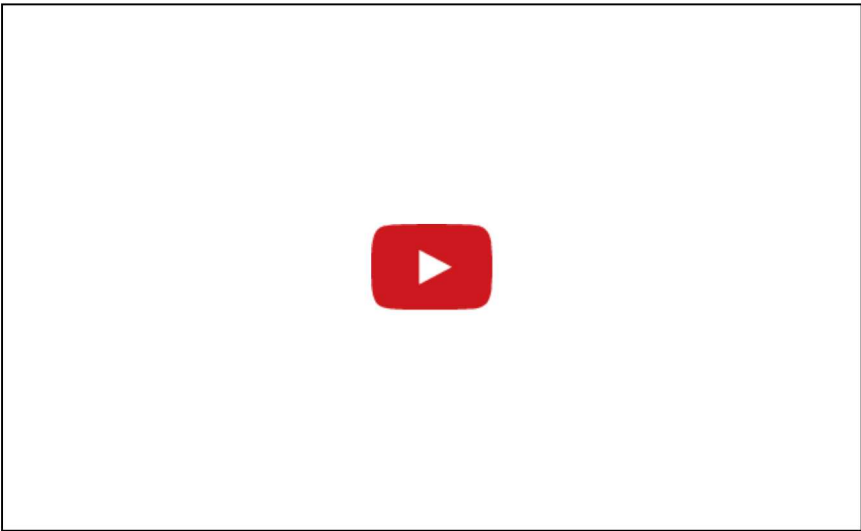
