What is great about this film is how it brings memories and feelings flooding back the instant it starts. Looking like it's been pirated more times than a black market copy of 'E.T. The Extra Terrestrial' in 1982, 'Adjust Your Tracking' introduces us to people who by the end of the film feel like old friends who we wanna hang with. Mainly headed up by Zack Carlson, and featuring the likes of Troma's Lloyd Kaufman, the cast of characters introduce us to their incredible collections (with amazing organization organization methods), vast haul stories and even huge bidding wars for rare tapes such as 1987's 'Tales from the Quadead Zone', proving that crap films can often command huge prices if they're rare.

Spending the past couple of years touring cinemas and film clubs throughout the US since its completion, it's great to see this great documentary getting a mainstream release for everyone to enjoy. VHS may not hold the appeal of vinyl, which many feel sounds better than other music formats. VHS films look like crap, they're clunky and they're 'outdated' but despite all this, they're in our heart! If you wanna take a trip to revisit an entertainment genre that literally dictated the film viewing methods of a generation, then this is just the ticket.
