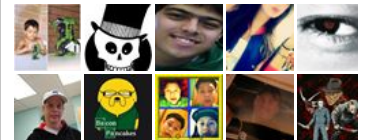

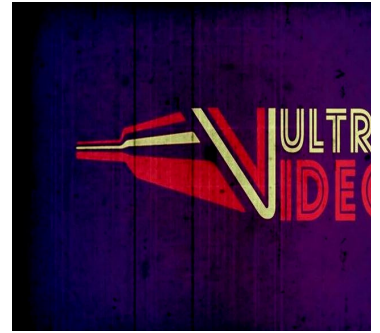

THE ANT ("Best of Fest" – 2013 LA Indie Film Fest) – Franky has been betrayed and everyone close to him soon discovers that vengeance is not what he seeks. He wants a lot more than that. AMUSED- After a lazy morning full of errands, Martha returns home to find a horror feasting upon her daughter's scalp. A terrifying chase ensues through the frozen countryside. Alone and desperate, Martha must race through the vast isolation as terror lurks and waits for its chance to pounce. DOPPELGANGER- A lonely skeleton goes on a perilous journey to find his own kind, only to find more than he bargained for in this tribute to Ray Harryhausen stop-action animation. THE NEST ("Best Foreign Short" – 2011 Atlanta Shortsfest) – A rancher must fight to survive when a swarm of over-sized flesh-eating bees escapes from a beekeeper who depends on their honey to keep her diner in business.

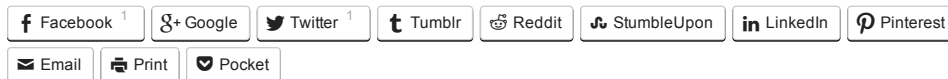


I like the concept of Hillbilly Horror Show. Basically, our three hillbilly host introduce a number of shorts. Each have their own quality and some are a lot shorter than others. It is a nice way to get different directors exposure and that is never a bad thing and the hillbilly gimmick isn't a bad one to have. I kind of wish we got more of them. All in all the movie is just a little over an hour, so you would think for the DVD at least we could get more of these characters because I feel they have much more to offer than they get the chance to here. The shorts are a mix like with all anthology films, I just wish we did a few minor things to make it feel like an anthology instead of like a collection of short Hillbilly Horror episodes. This could be done by holding off the end credits for each short until the end of the whole thing. It is a minor complaint, but it kind of takes you in and out of the whole experience when you have to sit through different sets of end credits before moving on to the next one.

The shorts have some that are better than others and to spite the amount of CGI used I found, The Nest, to be the best. It is also the longest, but could have easily been a fun full length I believe and you will be entertained by what you get with it here. A few are OK and some seem a little too short and simple, but there is nothing by any means terrible in this collection and it all makes for a very cool and fun viewing experience overall. I understand there another volume coming out soon and these can be a lot of fun for anyone wanting to kill an hour or so in front of the tube. It also doesn't hurt that Cousin Lulu is pretty easy on the eyes.

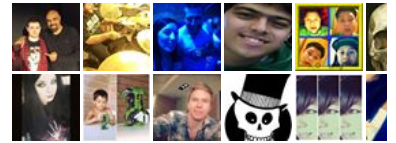
