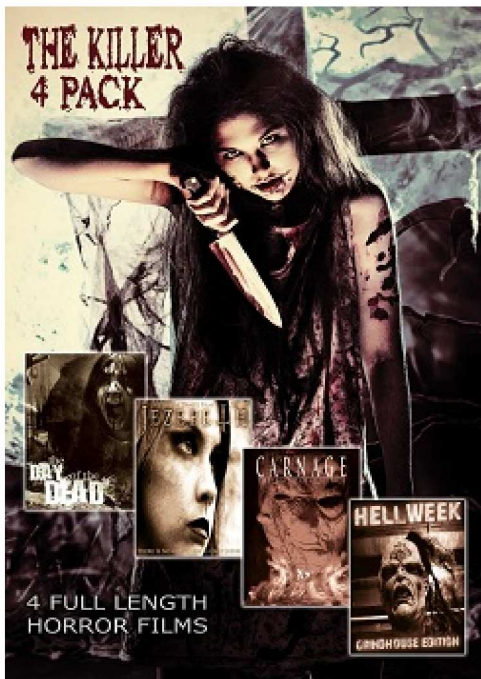




The Killer 4 Pack

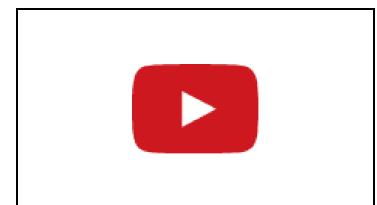
