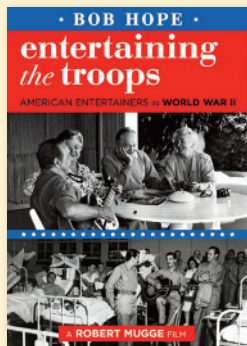

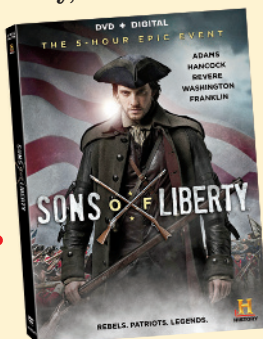

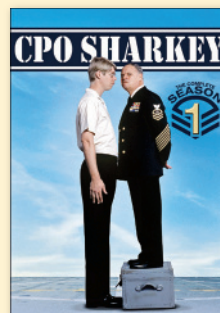

SONS Of Liberty is History's latest blockbuster. This action-packed

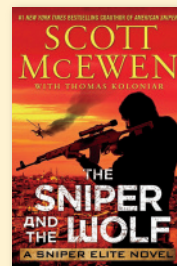

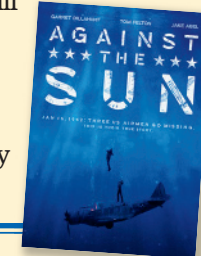

COUPLE WINS \$240,000 LAWSUIT FROM NEIGHBORS OVER DOG BARKING!

BARKING dogs can drive you crazy or — in the case of an Oregon couple — make you rich!

After being hounded for more than a decade by the incessant clamor of their neighbors' giant Tibetan mastiffs, Dale and Debra Krein were awarded \$240,000 in compensation by a jury.

Controversial surgery

The news is bad not only for the dogs' owners, John Updegraff and Karen Szwec, but also for the pooches because they've

been ordered to be "debarked."

The controversial surgery removes tissue from the animals' vocal cords, muffling their "woofs." The procedure is banned in

several states, and the animal rights group PETA calls it "surgery for human convenience."

But for the Kreins, it will offer relief. They claimed the dogs barked throughout the day and night. Meanwhile, Updegraff and Szwec insisted the mastiffs were needed to protect their livestock in rural Rogue River, but the jury didn't buy it.
