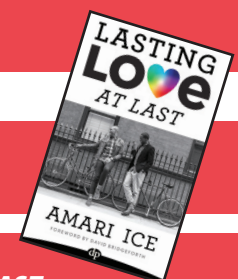


THE QUEER FANTASIES OF THE AMERICAN FAMILY SITCOM
