This album is pretty hit and miss. While Frank Caliendo is easily the star included, he just doesn't translate well to audio. Without seeing the impressions it falls short of the expectation he brings. Rob Cantrell delivers a solid set as does Gary Gulman, who has a laugh out loud a extremely logical bit about the technologically advanced state of the cookie empire. Bonnie McFarlane's set is the weakest by far but I'm I wondering she might translate better with video as well. 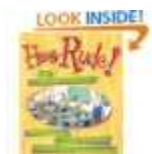
