**Winston Watson**

***Bob Dylan Never Ending Tour Diaries* DVD**

(Highway 61 Entertainment)

Often hokey and totally lacking any original Bob Dylan live or studio music, (unless you count Dylan's band intros and interviewer/filmmaker Joel Gilbert's laconic soundtrack), Winston Watson's *Bob Dylan Never Ending Tour Diaries* will undoubtedly be of interest to only the most ardent Dylanologist.

Though this serious Dylanologist found himself wondering when it would end, it is Watson's effervescence that carries the 100 minute runtime and makes his rags-to-riches rock 'n' roll story fun to listen to. The occasional clips of Dylan's band from mid-1992 thru August '96, does give the smallest glimpse of what eventually evolved into arguably Dylan's best back-up band since the Band, incorporating Larry Campbell, Charlie Sexton, Dave Kemper and Tony Garnier.

With that said, I can't help adding that *Bob Dylan Never Ending Tour Diaries* does eventually become a short commercial for Gilbert's Dylan Tribute band, in which Watson plays drums.
