DVD Review: The Rolling Stones – In The 1960's



There are few people that would argue that the 1960's were the decade for The Rolling Stones. As one person put it, The Stones were the antithesis of The Beatles. One of the more interesting aspects of the band is that initially they only played covers. In fact it was the Lennon/McCartney penned I wanna be your man that got them noticed, peaking at #12 in the UK charts.



The Rolling Stones – In The 1960's is a two DVD set that is jammed with historical clips. Although it is now 5 decades later, there is something wonderful to watch the band as young men. Their inspiration was very much in the Blues and R&B world. One only has to look at the covers that the young band played.
