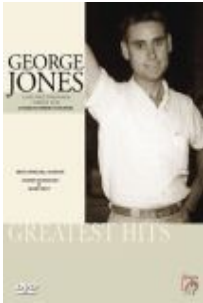

After his career had already been through the ups and downs that come with the music industry, George Jones had been labeled a legend and pioneer of country music. On this DVD, recorded at Church Street Station in Orlando, FL, Jones shows off his playful side when she pulls up to the venue in a convertible being driven by a scantily clad chauffeur and slapped the hands on the fans that stood outside the venue as he walked in. The cameras follow him to the stage as he straps on his guitar and gets the crowd singing and clapping right along with him as he opens with the tongue and cheek "No Show Jones," a documentary of the rumors of his life. The DVD continues and Jones brings a majority of his rocking countryside at the sold out crowd throughout the 60 minute performance that includes hits like: The Race Is On, He Stopped Loving Her Today, The One I Loved Back Then, and 5 more from his catalog. There is also a few songs included on here from Johnny Rodriguez and Mark Gray as well as some extra features that include a photo gallery, quiz, etc...Anyone that knows me will tell you that I am not someone that normally finds myself listening to the older more traditional brand of country, but the word respect does come to mind when you watch DVD's like this one.
