

# THE ROLLING STONES UNDER REVIEW: 1962-1966

THE ROLLING STONES UNDER REVIEW: 1962-1966 (MVD) By Bob Cooper

This DVD is essentially a documentary; or rather an independent critical analysis of what many consider to be the worlds greatest rock and roll band, The Rolling Stones, as seen through the eyes of some of the people who were there in the bands' beginning. People like former Melody Maker writer Chris Welch, friend of the band Keith Altman, original Stones bassist Dick Taylor, and Stones bodyguard/bus driver Tom Keylock tell the Stones stories from an insiders view, relaying many interesting events throughout the bands' early career.

This video takes the PBS approach in this film, and includes some very rare live performance videos and lots of rare personal photographs while chronologically telling their stories. Much of the footage is black and white, and the sound recordings are "marginal" as compared to today's standard, but really add an ambience to the film. Previously not much of this material was made available, and the Stones personal lives have always been kept pretty private, so there is much to be learned here- not the least of which is the importance of Brian Jones membership in the band before his untimely death. In the beginning, he was a major driving force in the band besides adding much of the signature instrumentation to most of their hits, from the blues covers up through the period when Mick and Keith actually began writing original tunes. This video is an education in the history of The Stones, and while a bit dry to be musically entertaining it is a truly honest documentary of one of the planets most successful and longest- running rock acts.
