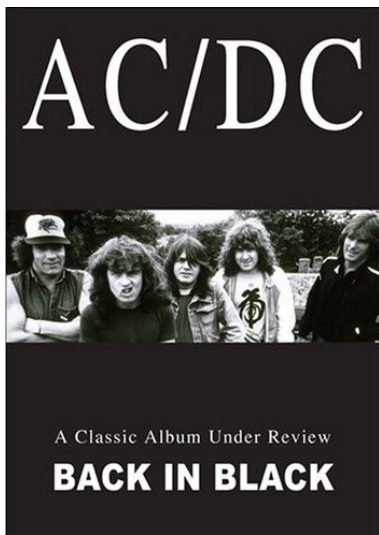




AC/DC A Classic Album Under Review - Back in Black
