OK Computer: A Classic Album Under Review (Sexy Intellectual)

OK Computer is undoubtedly one of the best albums of the last decade, and possibly of all-time - a perfectly timed mixture of classic song-writing and sonic exploration that turned a lot of people on their heads upon its release in 1997. As with other volumes of the "Under Review" series, this DVD revisits that album through the eyes of a host of music critics and authors such as Mark Paytress (author of Radiohead: A Guide To Their Music), Barney Hoskyns (ex-Mojo editor), Dai Griffiths (who authored the OK Computer volume of the 33 1/3 seires), among others who offer their opinion on each of the tracks and the album-making process. While the album is a classic and its story does deserve to be told, without the input from the band itself or other Radiohead insiders (this DVD isn't authorized by the group), this is nothing more than a filmed version of an article, and that's just not an exciting proposition.
