List Price: \$19.95; MVD Visual.


This is Tony Palmer's early masterpiece documenting music and its effect on pop culture in the late '60s, with previously unseen footage from The Beatles, Cream, Jimi Hendrix, The Who, Pink Floyd and many more. Produced and initially broadcasted in 1968, this compelling documentary is just as pertinent and relevant as ever. Now for the first time, this 60 minute BBC Film is available on home video.



ANDERSON, BRUFORD, WAKEMAN, HOWE - AN EVENING OF YES

List Price: \$19.95; MVD Visual. This performance was captured on the American leg of the 1989 world tour and finds the band performing not only material from the self titled album but also classic material from YES including Starship Trooper, Close To The Edge and also And You And I. The DVD comes complete with the original Roger Dean artwork, a photo booklet, and new sleeve notes. Anderson, Bruford, Wakeman, Howe made up of four fifths of the classic YES lineup from the seventies.

THE BYRDS: Under Review
List Price: \$24.95; MVD Visual. A documentary film which explores the music, career and background of one of America's most influential bands. With the aid of many who were there at the time, this 2 DVD set is a celebration of one of Rock n' Roll's great bands. It includes rare and classic performances re-assessed by a panel of experts, live and studio recordings of Byrds classics, footage and interviews from then and now, and exclusive and extensive contributions from Byrds members.



AL DI MEOLA - SPEAK A VOLCANO: RETURN TO ELECTRIC GUITAR

List Price \$19.95; MVD Visual. After 30 years of exploring a variety of styles, Al Di Meola still ranks among the most popular guitar masters of jazz and jazz-rock. Here, on his first "electric" DVD, Di Meola rediscovers his love of the electric guitar, and the result is a balancing act between volcanic electronic ecstasy and emotionally moving sound excursions, including many compositions of Di Meola himself, and five Piazzolla tunes.

GUNS N' ROSES: 2 Classic Albums Under Review - Use Your Illusion I and II

List Price: \$19.95; MVD Visual. This DVD features rare footage of Guns n' Roses including exclusive backstage film rarely seen before;

lengthy interviews from musicians and vocalists who were there working on the records and the tour; comment from friends; insight and critique from biographers, journalists and DJs. Also included are seldom seen photographs, location shots, news footage and much more.

GREG LAKE: Welcome Backstage
List Price: \$39.99; MVD Visual. Exclusive insight into Lake and his band in pre-tour rehearsals, capturing a selection of full length tracks, excerpts from backstage footage and interviews. From his initial days in the explosive London music scene of the late 1960s, through his time as founding member and voice of rock innovators King Crimson, and Emerson, Lake and Palmer.

MOTT THE HOOPLE: Under Review
List Price: \$19.95; MVD Visual. A 90-minute documentary film charting the career and music of one of rock's most influential yet often neglected bands. Despite being championed by many of modern cultures coolest names — from David Bowie and Morrissey to the Clash and the Sex Pistols. The DVD features review, commentary, critique and insight from keyboardist Morgan Fisher, Mick Jones - Clash guitarist/co-songwriter and many more.



MOUNTAIN - LIVE IN PARIS 1985
List Price: \$19.95; MVD Visual. This performance has rarely been seen until now. Formed in 1969 by the guitarist Leslie West and bassist/producer Felix Pappalardi, Mountain became one of the highest grossing rock acts on the music scene between the years 1969 and 1972. Sadly, Pappalardi died in 1983. In 1985 the band reformed and were asked to play on the Deep Purple European tour. This DVD contains a set consisting of their finest moments - including Nantucket Sleighride, Never In My Life, Mississippi Queen and Theme For An Imaginary Western.

PINK FLOYD: Meddle - Classic Album Under Review
List Price: \$19.95; MVD Visual. This DVD offers a new level of insight into the band during the build up, recording and aftermath of their most significant musical turning point. Use of performance footage, long forgotten photographs, contributions from friends and colleagues, review, criticism and insight from a panel of esteemed experts and more. Features live and studio performances from the Meddle era, re-assessed by a panel of experts, and obscure footage and unseen photographs.

QUEEN: Under Review 1980-1991 - The Freddie Mercury Story
List Price: \$19.95; MVD Visual. This documentary includes historical musical performances re-assessed by a panel of experts, as well as obscure

footage, rare interviews and rarely seen photographs. It also contains review, comment, criticism and insight from; Broadcaster and friend of Freddie, Paul Gambaccini; Peter Stringfellow; Wayne Sleep; Rock Journalists; DJ Paul Burnett; and Freddie Mercury tribute artists. In addition, live and studio recordings of Mercury's finest moments have been added, as well as footage of and comment of his musical influences.



KEITH RICHARDS: Under Review
List Price: \$19.95; MVD Visual. This DVD features a 2 hour documentary film which details the life and career of the one man who made it all seem possible. It includes rare and classic musical performances re-assessed by a panel of experts, exclusive interviews, obscure footage and seldom seen photographs. Also included is footage of and comment on Keith's pivotal influence, live and studio recordings of classics such as Satisfaction, Jumping Jack Flash, Brown Sugar, Tumbling Dice, Start Me Up and many others, plus bonus features.

BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN: Under Review-1978-82 - Tale of

the Working Man
List Price: \$19.95; MVD Visual. Although Bruce Springsteen's huge body of work has had its highs and its not so highs, there is one distinct period within his career that remains his most creative, consistent, and satisfying - The trilogy of albums he released between 1978 and 1982, comprising Darkness On The Edge Of Town, The River and Nebraska. This documentary film looks again at these albums, and the shows he performed around them.

NEIL YOUNG: Under Review 1976-2006
List Price: \$19.95; MVD Visual. A documentary film reviewing the music and career of one of the finest songwriters and most significant artists of the rock age - during the second half of his career. It includes live and studio recordings of Neil Young classics re-appraised by a panel of contributors, and obscure footage, rare interviews and seldom seen photographs. It also includes review, comment, criticism and insight from; John Einarson, author of the biography 'Neil Young: Don't Be Denied'; respected rock critic Robert Christgau; and British rock author Barney Hoskins.
