

Bruce Springsteen - *Under Review 1978-1982: Tales Of The Working Man*

The American rocker Bruce Springsteen had his best years between the mid-Seventies and the mid-Eighties, between the albums [*Born To Run*](#) (which made him famous) and [*Born In The U.S.A.*](#) (his most successful record). This documentary presents briefly these 2 albums, but especially the 3 discs he did between them, [*Darkness On The Edge Of Town*](#), [*The River*](#) and [*Nebraska*](#). Several specialists talk about his best years as an author, making of Springsteen the worthy successor to **Bob Dylan**. Through comments of specialists, we can discover various music extracts or interviews with the singer himself. The 82-minute documentary does a very good portrait of this legendary American singer, which thus makes of it an interesting DVD for his fans. On the other hand, there are a few interesting elements for those who don't know well his work.
