



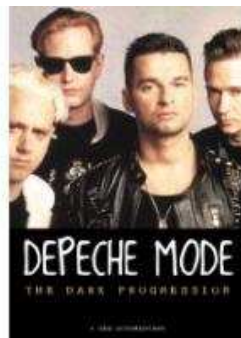

### Depeche Mode

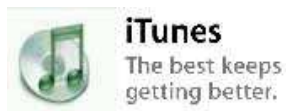
#### The Dark Progression DVD
