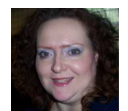

Rex Romanski the stud of the film is delivered by the sexual charisma and the suave **Michael Reed**, who is Mr. Romance in this fun sexual exploitation film. The story starts off with sex and follows through a whole string of carnal explorations of the male and female body. Rex is modeled after (another smooth ladies man from the era) Tony Manero's character in **Saturday Night Fever** with John Travolta. Both actors are and were suited for their characters. Just like I couldn't imagine anyone else playing Tony Manero but John Travolta... without **Michael Reed**...I don't think I would have liked Rex's character as much as I did. I loved him as Jesus in **Nun of That** and he nailed it, pardon my pun, as Rex in **Disco Exorcist**.

Rex Romanski is the topic of three women's conversation as they are drinking and watching him on the dance floor romancing another woman. All the women have had a go with him and are being on the catty side of snide with their remarks, while behind them another woman is listening and watching Rex. She leaves from her ease dropping position and makes her way toward Rex. Their eyes meet and moments later a dance off between them ensues and the result is sex back at Rex's. The enchantress is red haired Rita Marie (**Ruth Sullivan**) who wants more from sexy Rex. But Rita finds out Rex is not a one-woman-man, enter Amoreenia Jones (**Sarah Nicklin**) a popular porn star who catches the eye of Rex and whisks him away from Rita.

Unbeknownst to Rex and Amoreenia...Rita is a practitioner of the Dark Arts and she puts a curse on Amoreenia that causes a demonic possession that leads to black outs and attempts to kill Rex. All the mumbo jumbo aside this possession is starting to put a crimp in Rex's sex life with Amoreenia. He is forced to look for help in the oddest of places and what happens when Rex attempts to free Amoreenia from her demon is a eye opening, mind blowing experience, that all of you should witness. It contains all the sex, nudity, fun and zany characters you can expect from writers and director of **Disco Exorcist**. The acting although not academy award winning is mediocre to good. Michael Reed is a scream and Sarah Nicklin's transformation from beauty to beast is cool and Ruth Sullivan's scenes were raw and fared well with a woman scorned. Overall, I enjoyed the story. It comes across as a spoof film, thus making this a horror comedy for me. The lampooning of the certain characters from Saturday Night Fever in Disco Exorcist was a kick, especially when viewer learns the true nature of a particular character, which was something that crossed my mind while watching Saturday Night Fever. This movie is totally tongue-in-cheek...literally in some instances, but it was fun.

The look of the film is vintage and complete with the adding of lines and crackle to give it that 70's aged look and feel. Originally Richard Griffin wanted to film with 8mm camera to give it that authentic look, but it proved to be more expensive, so he resorted to digital. Even at that, his movie has character and movie watchers will be looking at the story and not attention to the details. For those that are interested in the making of the film and the formats used...it was well done. I have seen his other movies and am a fan of content and format.

In closing, this film reminds me of another fan favorite...Boogie Nights with Mark Walberg...if you liked it...you will love Disco Exorcist.
