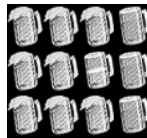

### IS IT A GOOD MOVIE?

Coming down the pike with a clear grind house-retro vibe, The Disco Exorcist would fit right in with any of those exploitative and raunchy old crapfests- and I say that with love. This movie starts off with a bang, just covering the screen with as much drugs, sex and gore that it possibly can and never lets up.

The story is pretty predictable as our main man Rex Romanski hooks up with the wrong crazy broad who falls in love with him, thinking he's the one. When Rex decides to hook up with local porn legend Amoreena Jones, Rita uses her skills with the dark spirits to infect Amoreena and possess her like nobody's business.

Of course, this also comes with a price. The movie looks, feels and IS cheap, but that can be part of its charm. If you aren't into tons of nudity, really bad wigs and some less than stellar special effects, you

should probably not consider this one. The acting is pretty goofy too, and the whole production is way more goofy comedy than it is a serious film, if you couldn't tell already. In fact, as another warning, you should know there's a ton of sex in this movie. Yes, it's a grindhouse tribute, but know that there's a ton of simulated sex. I dig it, but this isn't for everyone.

The tongue of this film is planted firmly in its cheek, and there's plenty to smile about, and shockingly enough, there's a fair amount of decent dialogue and some pretty funny jokes. Did I laugh the whole time? Naw, I didn't, but that doesn't mean I wasn't mostly entertained. One of my only real complaints about this flick is that I felt it was a bit long for my liking. The whole thing felt a bit stretched, but that's a minor quibble.

Also, it's worth noting that Rex might come off like a bit of a cool jerk, but he has something about him that doesn't inspire hatred. You'll find yourself rooting for the guy. I often find that with low budget indie flicks the creators are far too concerned with making the main character "cool" and the audience ends up rating him and the film loses all momentum. Chalk it up to a fun performance from actor Mike Reed, I guess. I know I said most of the acting is hammy, but I'd be remiss if I didn't mention Ruth Sullivan, who plays Rita. She's not the best actress, but that girl is hot and she goes absolutely NUTS later in the film when her time to go crazy comes around. Impressive.

At the end of the day, the Disco Exorcist looks like a bad 70s disco horror flick, and absolutely is one. It accomplishes what it promises, and for that I commend it. Will I put it in my collection permanently? Maybe not, but I'd sure be happy to watch it again and have a laugh with some friends.
