Hurwitz co-produced, engineered and performed on The Band’s last three CDs, “Jericho,” “High On The Hog” and “Jubilation.” Other credits include two CDs with Ireland’s Four Men and A Dog, The David Nelson Band’s “Visions Under The Moon,” Danko’s “Live On Breeze Hill” and “Times Like These,” and with The Crowmatix on “The Sea To The North” by Garth Hudson.
