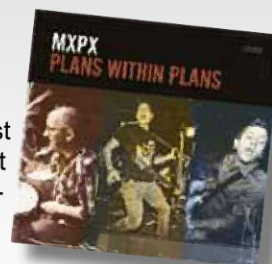

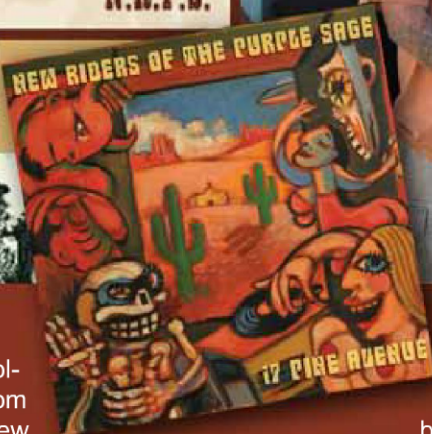
MXPX Plans Within Plans
