New Riders Of The Purple Sage will release their first studio album in three years, 17 Pine Avenue, on March 6. The album features the seminal group's current lineup of original members David Nelson and Buddy Cage along with Michael Falzarano, Ronnie Penque and Johnny Markowski.
