Contributing to the new songs is Nelson song writing partner and long time Grateful Dead icon Robert Hunter. Guesting here is Professor Louie. Many of these tracks pick right up from that classic "psychedelic Americana" period on that first NRPS album with Jerry Garcia from 1971.
