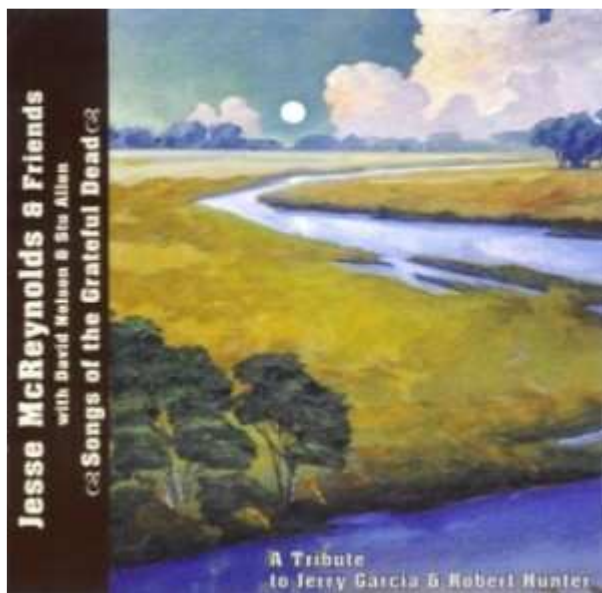




Jesse McReynolds Releases Tribute to Jerry Garcia & The Grateful
