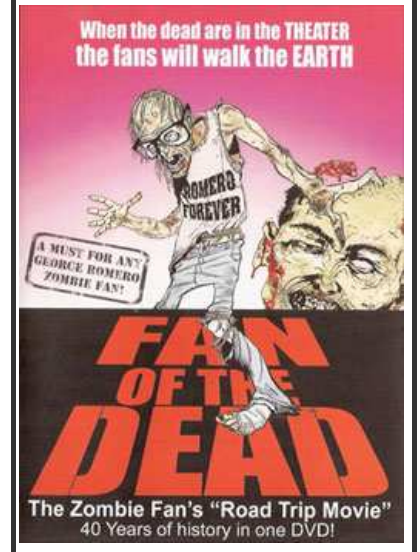
--THE PLOT

--VIDEO

The film is presented in a 1.33:1 full screen transfer. The print does the job, it's the camerawork and lighting itself that can be a bit off at times as it is very low-budget and clearly a home video. Sometimes the camerawork is very shaky and the lighting inadequate, but for what it is it's perfectly fine.

--AUDIO

Once again there's nothing to get too excited about. Dolby Digital 2.0 soundtrack which isn't spectacular. The overdub track on this release is preferable to the copy that Umbrella Entertainment has as an extra on the [Dawn of the Dead](#) release. The Umbrella release has a female doing the dub track which is really odd. Sometimes you can hear Nicolas over the overdub which is a bit of a nuisance at times as it makes it harder to listen to the English commentary.

--FINAL THOUGHTS

[Fan of the Dead](#) is a fairly dry documentary. It's really a video diary of a hardcore Romero fan's travels to America to visit locations where Romero films were shot. Garreau attends a convention and interviews some people who appeared in various Romero films which are probably the highlights of the film. What fails to make the documentary entertaining is that it's just a fan touring around the landmarks, it's something we all could do and I am sure true hardcore fans of Romero already have. It's just not that exciting listening to someone be excited over visiting the basement where [Night of the Living Dead](#) was shot, of course if you were there yourself it would be amazing.

This documentary is an extra on Umbrella Entertainment's Ultimate Edition and Blu-Ray edition of [Dawn of the Dead](#) and serves much better as an extra than a feature. You really have to LOVE Romero films to dig this documentary. It's not bad, it's just not that exciting
