

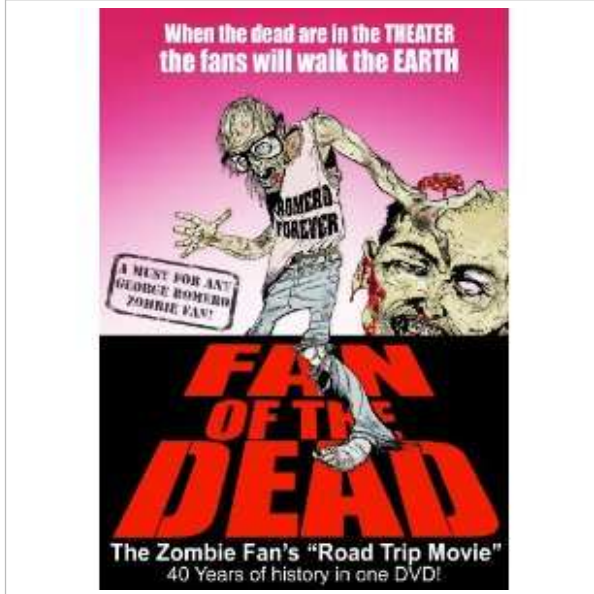

Romero's *Night of the Living Dead* (1968). It was at the Walker Theater in Brooklyn, during a revival showing in the early '70s. Then *NotLD* came on, and by the time it was over, we were all sitting together.
