Bring on the Trailers!!! Trailer Compilation DVD Reviews

This review is for no

one but two new releases from MVD releasing that focus on vintage nostalgia collections from the past. The first titl am covering is an exhaustive collection of 405 minutes of vintage trailers of everything from Horror and Exploitatio to Science Fiction and Action films. After that we will get a bit blue with the Sleazy 70s Stags collection.

Cheezy Trailer Extravaganza is a massive 5 disc set from Cheezy Flicks. Each disc contains about an hour of trailer well as a collection of intermission bumpers, trailers for other Cheezy Flicks releases and some information on the company.

The first disc is Cheezy Action trailers and features everything action oriented including pirates, cowboys and military movies. Honestly this was my least favorite of the discs as I am more of a horror and exploitation guy but there are still a lot of fun trailers included. Next is Cheezy Exploitation. It is a mix of old and new exploitation with a lot of stuff from the very old anti-pot and dangers of sex movies. It does eventually get into 70's titles which have some of the greatest trailers of all time. The chapter stops are conveniently set so that any trailer that doesn't hold your interest can be skipped. Next is Cheezy Fantasy. I quite liked this collection of Sword and Sandel and Monster trailers. One that stood out in particular was an old trailer for King Kong vs. Godzilla, a movie that we had on 8 mm film when I was a child. There are tons of classic monster trailers included, this is a great disc. Even better is the following discs Cheezy Horror Volume 1 and 2. There are tons of red band trailers included, such as Humanoids from the Deep and Texas Chainsaw Massacre and lots of obscure titles such as Black Zoo and Axe (I really want to dig up a copy of Axe!.) Of course these two were my favorite discs in the collection. I actually have volume 2 playing in the background while typing this. Rounding out the set are Cheezy Science Fiction Volumes 1 and 2. Both of these are stacked with classics as well and were a lot of fun to watch and reminisce.

These trailers are raw and have that scratched, grainy look that is trademark of the 70's. They do vary in quality but overall its a rough ride, which is kind of fun given what you are watching. Each disc contains a section of vintage Intermission bumpers and commercials as well, urging you to rush out to the concession stand and buy stuff. My favorite one has to be the Doctor Pepper concession break with the jungle natives yelling "Unga Bunga" before enjoying a refreshing soda. Another fun commercial bit features Julie Andrews explaining the MPAA rating system.

As a big fan of 70s and 80s cinema, I not only had a notepad filled with notes for my review but this time around I had a second one just to jot down movies that I either want to now hunt down and check out like the omnious "Axe," one of my favorite trailers from the horror collection or movies that I haven't seen for a long time but remember loving

back in the day, like Fantastic Voyage. Now there is a movie that needs a Blu Ray release!

The title is Sleazy 70's Stags 8 mm Loop Film Collection. Basically it is a collection of softcore films from the 1970s featuring actresses such as Candy Samples and Uschu Digard. Most of the footage consists of a woman stripping down while rubbing and squeezing her breasts, occasionally switching it up with extreme close ups of other bod parts that had much more hair back in the day. These grainy, streaky featurettes look exactly as they would on an old 8 mm camera and even end with the last black section of film sliding through the projector. Two of the segments feature Candy Samples gettin' it on with her man. There is no graphic intercourse, only softcore moments that make you glad that there are better alternatives to 70s porn today.

These clips are all silent although some have the old porn instrumentals intact, such as one featuring an older woman dressed as a cowgirl that I wouldn't mind forgetting, and are guaranteed to cause more laughter than arousal. The video also allows users to select particular actress segments and features a large collection of erotic trailers, including some hilarious vintage Belgian Sex comedies.

These movie trailers are a lot of fun to pop in and run in the background while entertaining or working around the house. Ok, maybe the Stag Films one not as often but it is a goofy fun background during a batchlor party or poker game... Both of these releases are pretty inexpensive and I definitely recommend the Cheezy Trailer Extravaganza set for fans of genre films.
