

Last time around in part 2, Shane Douglas or the Franchise as a lot of us call him, has vowed to come back and avenge his loss. Also, Ricky Morton (yes the one who was in the Rock and Roll Express) has vowed revenge for Kid Kash in part 2 and with Raven as his manager is also in the tournament which turns interesting when that crooked promoter Jake Reed has put a bounty on the head of Ricky and anyone who hurts or kills him during the tourney will pocket 10k. The whole while this tourney is going on the FBI who in the first two films were gathering info and trying to stop this are again on the heels of Jake Reed. This time who lives, who dies and who will pocket 10 million dollars.

Review-Where do I start? The selling points, you got TNA's Abyss without his mask. Raven had more of a role in this film then the other 2. I am a huge Raven fan. When he opens his mouth on a mic, to me its money. He plays Ricky Morton's voice of revenge. Ricky Morton was a surprise. Last time, it was Kid Kash in this role. This time, with a few changes it is Ricky. The scene with him in the

I think he has zero charisma and has no other talent other than to cling onto to people who helped him sky rocket and got by with his mediocre skills. The scenes with him seemed so scripted and really looked as bad as a TNA story line. The commentary was funny this time around. Al Snow really sold it, and for the first time in the three films, this time he hit so many one liners that did work and seemed so cheesy at times it was fun. Another positive is when Tommy Dreamer joined him on commentary. Anyone who has been a Dreamer fan, knows on the stick he is so dramatic that you sit there and think damn Tommy cheer up. Tommy could sell eyeglasses to the blind. And Val Venis was a wrestler who was doing this for his church. And boy you can tell Shawn wrote the script, he puts himself over more in this film than the wrestlers." Jake Reed is the smartest guy on this planet". I mean, another positive is the special guests. Scotty 2 Hotty, April Hunter and her fine self, Lodi, Stevie Richards. A wrestling match with Dreamer vs Douglas that was nostalgic. The negatives. Where the last film, had the big arena feel and the wrestling was so well done and felt fun, this felt more like the wrestling in the first film. They were again in some small gym, and the moves and matches just felt so uninspired. Even the final match where someone may or may not die, just was so uneventful. I did like the very end of the film. Shawn Cain has a funny comic timing. As a whole, I did not hate it, but coming off the very good Part 2 this just fell short. But, there is enough to almost forgive the bad stuff. Almost. A personal note to TNA, you failed on the ECW revival, the WWE 4th hand ideas, ROH talent, and WCW ideas that all failed. Shawn Cain with this trilogy has proven he has knowledge of the sport, maybe give him a shot. And, I am taking wagers that now they are rehashing their own successes, they will fail as well. If you watch TNA on a weekly basis, like I do. you may want to watch this trilogy. You may have fun with it more than you think. Hell, thank god Russo did not have a hand on these films. What about a UDM with female wrestlers? Hell, Mickie did Springer I know she would do this..and Roxxi would do it. And that Putski hottie would do it.
