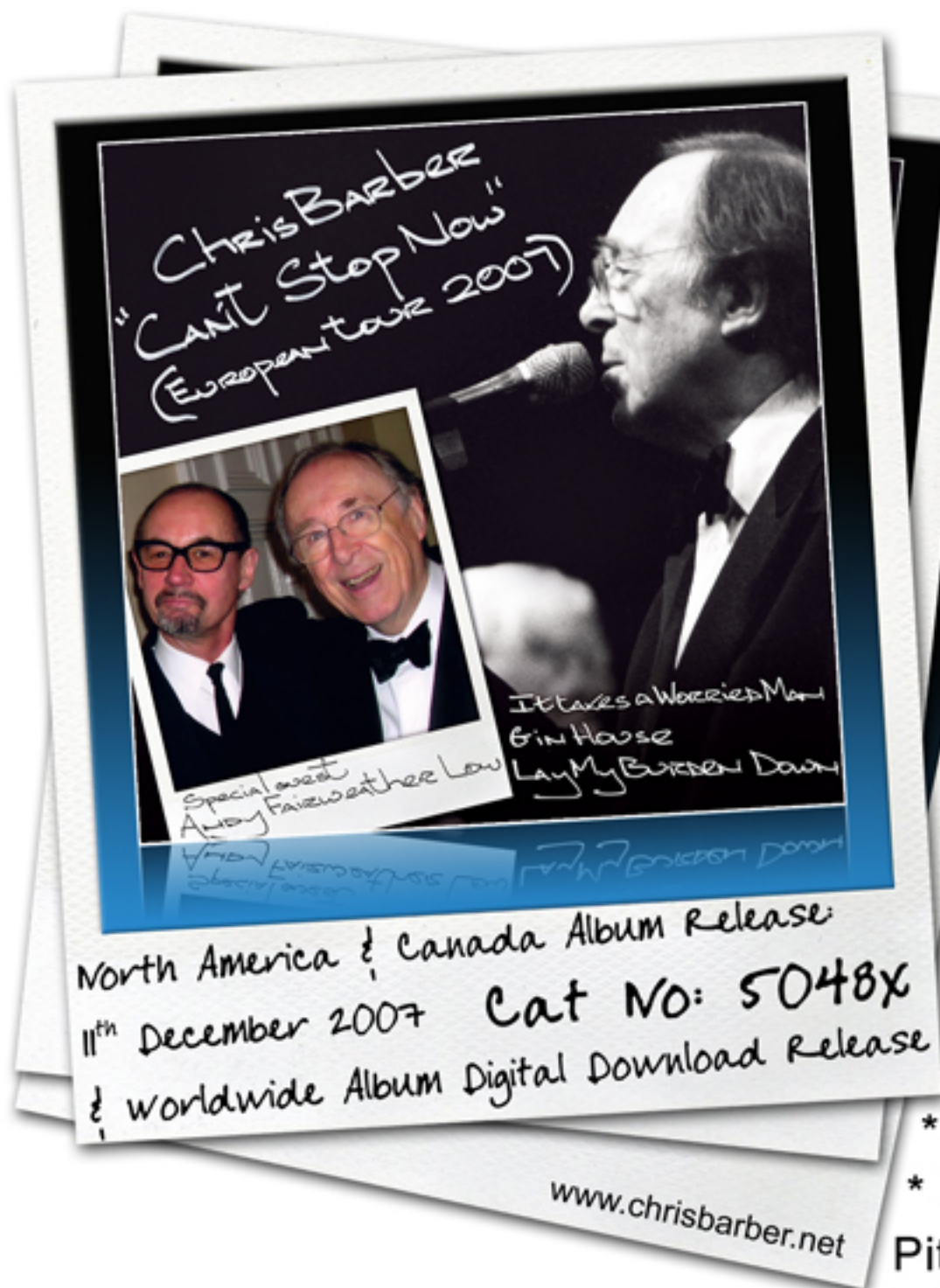

Chris Barber is an absolute iconic giant in the world of Jazz and Blues and the new album '**Can't Stop Now**' is ground-breaking in the evolution of a career that continues to expand over the past 5 decades working as a professional musician and band-leader.

The '**Can't Stop Now**' album (European Tour 2007) features the **Big Chris Barber Band** and a special guest appearance from **Andy Fairweather-Low** on 'Worried Man Blues', 'Gin House', and 'Lay My Burden Down'...

Andy Fairweather-Low was a founder member of Amen Corner who enjoyed chart success in the late 60's. Having performed and recorded with many top artists from Bill Wyman to the Who and Roger Waters, he is also known as a mainstay in Eric Clapton's band since the early 90's.

For Chris 2007 is a definitive stage in his career spanning over half a century and this is the first and inaugural album of fine quality music released in association with **Classic Studio T** on the **Blues Legacy** label.

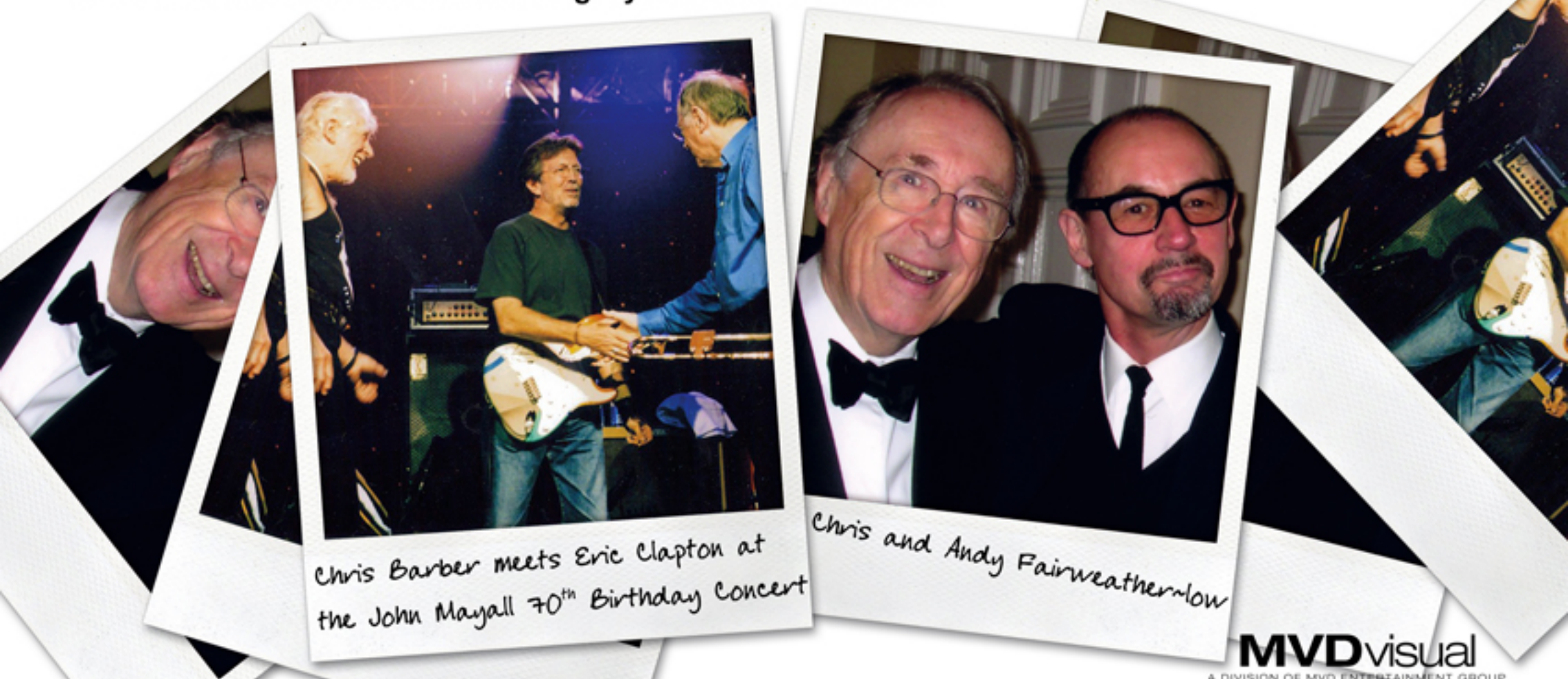
Chris Barber not only headed the extraordinary boom in the popularity of traditional Jazz in Britain and across Europe but also is the man responsible for bringing to the shores and concert halls of Britain such great Artists as **Muddy Waters, Sister Rosetta Tharpe, Sonny Boy Williamson, Sonny Terry & Brownie McGhee, Champion Jack Dupree, Louis Jordan, Howlin' Wolf and Jimmy Witherspoon**. As co-founder of the famous Marquee Club in London and the Richmond Jazz and Blues Festival (later known as the Reading Festival), Chris and his partner Harold Pendleton played a large part in starting and furthering the careers of **The Rolling Stones, The Who, Jimi Hendrix, The Yardbirds, Led Zeppelin, Alexis Korner and John Mayall....to name but a few!**

The accolades that have been paid to Chris are endless...at his 75th Birthday Tribute Concert he was introduced by participants **Bill Wyman** and **Andy Fairweather-Low** as **"a Giant of Jazz & Blues"** and **Van Morrison**, while singing an outstanding set, said **"Chris is an unsung hero of Jazz and Blues and it's been a pleasure to pay tribute to him"**.

At the 70th Birthday Concert for John Mayall where Chris, Eric Clapton and Mick Taylor were the special guests, **Eric Clapton** asked how long can Chris go on with his relentless schedule of live concerts and recordings.... Having performed over 10,000 concerts and made over 100 CDs Chris said simply **"I Can't Stop Now"**...and now that is the title of his first **Blues Legacy** album, released in association with **Classic Studio T**.

Previously Un-Released Material From Blues Legends

Watch out for further re-mastered and previously un-released material from legendary artists including **Chris Barber, Muddy Waters, Howlin' Wolf, Sonny Boy Williamson, Otilie Patterson, Champion Jack Dupree, Sister Rosetta Tharpe, Louis Jordan, Sonny Terry & Brownie McGhee**.
