probably the first and last Bobblehead you'll ever see on ToyCyte. A company called <u>Aggronautix</u> went and made, of all the anti-bobble things, a <u>GG Allin</u> blehead. And if DKE is game to distribute it with the rest of the lot of "art toys" (and Dov himself assimilated one into his personal collection), I'm down to write it.

This ghoulish effigy is a striking representation of GG ALLIN circa 1991. The figure, limited to 2000 numbered units, stands at 7 inches tall and is made of a lightweight polyresin. Displayed in a tri-windowed box, here GG is accurately sculpted right down to the tattoos, blood, and filth.

ceness is pretty dead-on, wouldn't you say? You can only hope that GG (born Jesus Christ Allin) would appreciate the transgressive irony of being made into a pop desktop ornament. Aggronautix also made a Tesco Vee of the Meatmen Throbblehead.
