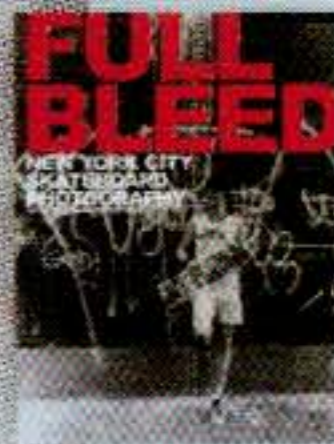




BOOK BEGS

Tired of scrolling? Try flipping a page for a change.



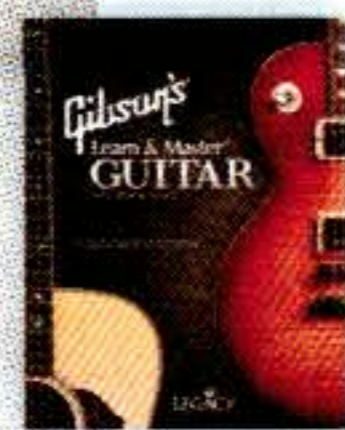
FULL BLEED; Andre Razo, Alex Corporan & Ivory Serra (\$22.95; powerhousebooks.com)
