I didn't think I'd ever be lucky enough to have another Superbees CD grace my stereo but 2010 has seen those very nice people at Acetate Records release this wonderful EP.

Straight from the off 'Silver Jet' sounds like a dirty stinking slab of gutter trashed rock 'n' roll flying through the airwaves with some superb Moon-the-loon-esque drumming just about holding this majestic racket together at its seams. Things only get better with the wah infused rip snorting death dance that is 'Bad News'.
