#### **Book Promotion:** *Babylon Twins*



Mangrove Program was initiated in 2016 for the purpose of expanding the reach of healthy black mangrove stands in the Biloxi Marsh while educating local youth on the benefits of revegetation as a coastal restoration application. Since the inception of the program, governmental, nongovernmental, and academic partners have potted and cultivated over 6,000 black mangroves in the Chalmette High School and Meraux Foundation greenhouses and planted approximately 3,000 mature plants in the Biloxi marsh. An additional 1,250 mature black mangroves

will be planted in April 2019.

#### **Traffic Control Imposed For Filming**

This past week Breakout Kings Productions, of New Orleans had traffic control imposed in the area of N. Peters, Pontalba, Angela and Mehle streets in Arabi for the filming of a portion of the television show, "Queens of the South" on location in the parish. The reason for the traffic controls was to ensure public safety and to help facilitate their work.

#### **Chandeleur Sound Living Shoreline Program**

The Chandeleur Sound living Shoreline program involves the construction and installation

of oyster breakwaters along the Northern edge of Comfort Island. The project was designed and permitted in 2018 to reduce north face erosion which is most destructive because it occurs during the dormant season for the plants that hold the island together. A preliminary design has been constructed at Nunez Community College by Welding students in the Chalmette High School Career Technical Education Workforce Development Program. The project is operating through a partnership between CHS-CTE, The Meraux Foundation, St. Bernard Parish, SSE and Nunez CC. The CSLS provides experiential learning by constructing and deploying the oyster breakwaters for this coastal restoration program in St. Bernard Parish. By the end of the fall 2019 semester, welding students will have constructed and deployed twenty (20) 4' X 6' X 3' units. These structures will be made of lightweight rebar

with a 2" enclosed area around the frame to hold Coquina shell stone which mimics the natural formation of oyster beds. The shape and weight of the structures will allow them to be easily stacked and transported. They will be transported by boat and installed along Comfort Island in the Chandeleur Sound. #### March 29 **Kiwanis Scholarships Application Deadline**
