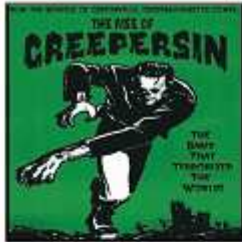

band Creepersin are hoping to generate some buzz with the re-issue of their 2005 debut platter. With a CD of new material slated to drop later this year, “The Rise of Creepersin” showcases the band’s early days.

Though not nearly as, well, creepy as their press material might lead you to believe, there is plenty to like about this 13-track release. You know what to expect from an album with song titles like “Bleed for Me,” “Dead By Dawn,” “Cleaverland,” “Coffin Drop,” “Get Off My Knife” and “To Dance With the Dead,” but the music is more melodic and Creepersin’s baritone vocals much clearer than I thought they’d be.
