A STROLL down memory lane has been a labour of love for Nils Lofgren. The guitar great has played and recorded with legends such as Bruce Springsteen, Neil Young and Lou Reed. But the E-Street Band member has also enjoyed a prolific and influential career in his own right. Nils recently released *Face The Music*, a 10-disc 164-track retrospective of his own work and it is that solo career that he will pay homage to when he takes the stage at Aberdeen's Music Hall tomorrow night.

A stroll down memory lane

Nils said: "The box set was a real stroll down memory lane and a labour of love. I was just grateful to play then, anywhere and everywhere. To look back 45 years and to handpick this music and to hear it all together is pretty stunning." At just 19 Lofgren joined Neil Young's Crazy Horse and played on legendary albums like *After The Gold Rush*, *Trans* and *Tonight's The Night*. He said: "For *Tonight's the Night* we would drink tequila, play pool, then start playing at midnight and record through the night. It was the roughest record ever made all live in the studio."
