



While this DVD is a documentary entitled *Under Review* on Queen from 1980 to 1991, it isn't sanctioned by the band and Queen doesn't appear in interview form within, there are clips of performances from the eras in question. The story is told by friends, journalists of the band, in a respectful classy way. While this particular DVD can't compete with the series "*Classic Albums*" it does offer some new light on the happening within Queen during that period of 11 years, from the release of one of the most hated albums of Queens catalog "Hot Space," to the controversial clip (for that time) "I Want to Break Free," their gig in Sun City, Africa to their comeback album "The Miracle" to Freddie's ultimate passing due to HIV/AIDS. This DVD clocks in at approximately 78 minutes and features some background information on each person that contributed interview segments to this documentary and also an interactive and informational Queen quiz. Overall the work within is well done and would made a great addition to any Queen diehard's collection.
