Three free jazz compositions--"Celestial Fantasy," "Shadow World," "Strange Strings," are performed by The Arkestra which in parts reminds me very much of Miles Davis's work in the '70s. The trumpet player sends out random notes which somehow don't seem so random. I'd swear Miles was playing the part. Sun Ra was definitely ahead of his time, whatever interplanetary measure he was using.

Also included on the disc are four short recitations by Sun Ra recorded in the '60s. He accompanies himself on Wurlitzer electric piano on three of them. They seem to have been recorded in a room somewhere, street noises are heard along with the sound of the recorder being turned on and off. My favorite title of the bunch is "Truth Is Bad."

Sun Ra was a very unique, talented, visionary, dedicated musician. He was born in May 22, 1914 in Birmingham, Alabama and died May 30, 1993. His real name was Herman P. Blount and he was also known as Sonny. He changed his legal name to Le Sony'r Ra for reasons that I have not gone into here. Suffice it to say that he believed he was from another planet, and he very well might have been right. 
