Blues, rags & extras

Tony Glover and local filmmaker **Rick Fuller** have put together a DVD version of the 1986 documentary "Blues, Rags & Hollers: The **Koerner, Ray & Glover** Story," which goes on sale Aug. 7.

Even a DVD on a trio of old-timey acoustic bluesmen has to have its extras, and this one fills that demand. It includes 25 minutes of previously unavailable performances from 1991 to 1999, much of it from the old cable show "The Cedar Social." Glover also added a postscript on **Dave Ray's** 2002 death and the trio's various going-ons before then.

"Trying to narrow down the choices to fit into the half-hour time slot we had on the DVD was tough," said Glover, who will be selling the DVD at the next show by his "new" trio **V3** at the Grand Av. Dunn Bros. on Aug. 11. "It was all pretty damn good, and brought back just how much Dave's missed."

As for Fuller, the music-video vet also has produced a documentary on the late folk star **Tim Buckley** (Jeff's dad), "My Fleeting House," which earned great press off several film fests.
