### 25 HATED: GG ALLIN AND THE MURDER JUNKIES (1994)

Deranged punk rock hero GG Allin in a nutshell: Heroin junkie. Sticks bottles up his ass. Takes shits on stage and rolls around in glass. Once slammed a microphone into his clenched mouth, breaking six of his own teeth. Lets hookers pee in his mouth. Spent time in jail for assaulting a young woman in Michigan. Adored by John Wayne Gacy. Died from a drug overdose on June 28, 1993. Sound like your cup of tea? Todd Phillips (Old School, Starsky & Hutch) made this disgustingly great documentary, "the highest-grossing student film of all time" according to Box Office magazine, while he was a film student at NYU. For real sickos, there's 50 minutes of bonus footage: "GG Allin Live At The Gas Station." BETCHA DIDN'T KNOW After GG visited John Wayne Gacy in prison, Gacy told a mutual friend, "That GG, man, great kid, I like that guy a lot. Love him like a brother, but man, if he doesn't stink like the worst, pissiest-assed wino I've ever met in my life."

#### 24 ROCK 'N' ROLL HIGH SCHOOL: ROCK ON EDITION (1979)

The Ramones star in this campy, racy tale about a bunch of loco students at the fictional Vince Lombardi High School. The anarchy is lead by vixenish rebel Riff Randell (P.J. Soles), who's so obsessed with the Ramones that she camps out—alone—to see them play live and fantasizes that they're in her bedroom while she's high on weed. To the delight of trench coat Mafiosos everywhere, the kids blow up the high school at the end while the Ramones play "Rock 'n' Roll High School."

# 23 MAYOR OF THE SUNSET STRIP (2003)
