

REVIEW SCALE

- 5 – The album is excellent, it could also be considered perfect or near perfect. There may be a few glitches or setbacks, but they are not detrimental.
- 4 – The album is very good. There aren't too many glitches or setbacks but the ones that are present keep the album from being excellent.
- 3 – The album is mediocre. While the album is alright, there isn't anything that makes it stand out above other albums. Some of it is good, and some of it needs work.

Danzig's *Evillive* label has put together a compilation of music videos that have rarely been seen and some that haven't been seen at all. *Archive De La Morte* features videos for six tracks and multiple versions of some of the music videos. The tracks featured here are; "Dirty Black Summer," "How the Gods Kill," "Sistinas," "It's Coming Down," and "Mother '93" which appears here in the live form that broke Danzig. "Mother '93" made Danzig a household name for at least a couple of years after its release and a staple on MTV. Glenn has put together a nice collection of videos here of classic Danzig material. My favorites on *Archive De La Morte* are; "How the Gods Kill" R rated version, "Sistinas" which is unreleased and "It's Coming Down" R rated version.
