



New York - ONO's current dance scorcher "Hell In Paradise" (The Remixes) hits #8 (with a bullet) on the Billboard Club Play Chart (June 26th issue). With contagious reconstructions from dance floor favorites Murk and The Orange Factory, as well as Iberican heavyweights Chus & Ceballos and LA production duo Minge Binge, the politically-charged single furthers ONO's awe-inspiring transformation into dance / electronic music's most unlikely, and electrifying, heroine.

"Hell In Paradise" perfectly sets the stage for ONO's next invention - the explosive and soon-to-be notorious "Every Man/Every Woman..." to be released on Mind Train / Twisted Records.

With "Every Man/Every Woman..." the pop culture icon tackles the controversial same sex marriage issue head on. ONO's original song "Everyman Has A Woman Who Loves Him" (from the Lennon/Ono multi-platinum 1980 set Double Fantasy) serves as the basis for multiple versions of a passionate and urgent call-to-arms celebrating all people who want to consummate their love for each other.

For the forthcoming release, ONO re-cut the vocals to include the new incarnations "Every Man Has A Man Who Loves Him" and "Every Woman Has A Woman Who Loves Her", in addition to versions with the original lyrics. Like her previous remix releases (including the #1 Billboard Club Play smash "Walking On Thin Ice"), "Every Man/Every Woman..." has been brilliantly re-worked into a series of searing and euphoric pop and dance floor anthems, courtesy of an international line-up of pop, dance, and electronic music innovators: Basement Jaxx, Blow-Up, Ralphie Rosario, Dave Aude, Murk, The Passengerz, and DJ Vibe.

"With both 'Hell In Paradise' and the upcoming 'Every Man/Every Woman...'" release we've opted to explore and then synthesize ONO's views on serious and, often, controversial issues with the more carefree and escapist energy of contemporary club and pop culture" explains Mind Train Managing Director Rob Stevens. "This fusion has created some highly-charged material that is inspired, provocative, and entertaining".

An admittedly bold statement and daring move, ONO comments on "Every Man/Every Woman...": "I find it strange that there should be so much controversy about this issue in a modern society. In these turbulent times, how wonderful it is for anyone, regardless of sexual orientation or gender, to find love. We should embrace, share, celebrate and validate that love. Every man has a man who loves him! Every woman has a woman who loves her!"

Dieselboy – The Dungeonmaster's Guide (D & B Mix CD / System Recordings)
