Finally, fans of relentless punk rock and roll based on the fine tradition of a long documentary that Sub Pop did not want you to see! Officially released in 2001, this documentary by James Bazan and Jeff Baker follows the band's rock and roll onslaught on the road.

Bonuses are a pair of videos ("Bunkhouse" and "18 Wheels") as well as their roadie, passers-by, and family, interspersed with live footage. That's both for sound and visual.

The rock and roll racket is comprised into an hour's running time (including a "fill of gas and pushing the van" shot) from a year's worth of shooting. In the hardcore scene, the members of The Murder City Devils are soft spoken and their music and attitudes. Who knows what contractual red tape had to do to lay off... they still have their catalogue in print, so pick up a disc

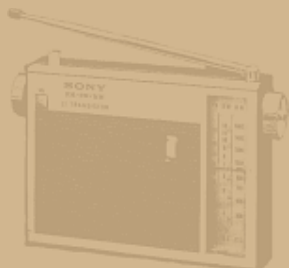

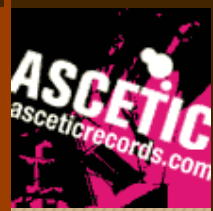
