Screamers

Jello Biafra (The Dead Kennedys) called Los Angeles punk music pioneers The Screamers "the best unrecorded band in the history of Rock 'n Roll," and this video record of a live 40-minute set in San Francisco on September 2 of 1978 shows exactly why. Lead singer Tomata du Plenty (David Xavier Harrigan) takes his Iggy-inspired performance art to a whole other level of enigmatic surrender. The synth and drums-based band perform infamous songs like "Beat Goes On" and "In A Better World" with more fury and psychotic shape shifting than you could ever imagine without seeing it. The life, work and methods of revered psychoanalyst Carl Gustav Jung is explored through interviews, personal home movies, excerpts from his writings and rare archival footage for a fascinating and informative understanding of C.G. Jung's opinions and philosophies. Jung's revolutionary ideas regarding the "totality of man" and the "life of the individual" are mirrored in the philosopher's generous attention to every aspect of human emotion, archetypes and the subconscious. Special features include 21 minutes of footage of Jung at Bollingen Tower Retreat in 1951, and a 30-minute interview with Jung for a British television talk show called "Face to Face" in 1959.
