DVD REVIEWS



'Marillion: Marbles on the Road'

(DVD / NR / 2005 / Music Video Dist.)

Overview: Filmed July 10th & 11th, 2004 at the Astoria in London, England, this DVD captures the band on rare form from the Marbles tour at the end of the first leg. This is the first Marillion video release to retail since 1990; specifically recorded for a DVD release, the soundtrack is presented in 5.1 surround sound, mixed by Michael Hunter.

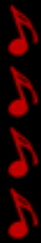
DVD Verdict: This DVD, like the title indicates, includes a performance from the Marbles tour (2004). The tracks included carry a powerload comparable to a performance by Peter Dinklage, someone that comes to mind quite often while seeing Steve Hogarth (the band's frontman) deliver. Nice too is the "rough" feel of the performance, where not even the mistakes are edited out, as in the case of a song that Hogarth starts singing off tune, to later correct it. Complementing the eleven "Marbles" live tracks are the following from past albums: Disc 1: "Bridge", "Living with the big lie", "Between you and me", "Uninvited Guest" and "Cover My eyes". Disc 2: "This is the 21st Century", "Quartz", "Estonia", "Afraid of Sunlight", "The Great Escape", "King" and "Easter". Up to here, all performances were recorded during the same show of the Marbles tracks, at the Astoria, London, 10-11 of July, 2004. In addition to these, disc 2 also includes four tracks from the Marillion Weekend 2003, at a time when the Marbles album was only in the works. They share four tracks from the album to be released the following year in here, under the title "The Video that should have never been seen" (or something like that). Finally, though truly not the high point of the DVDs, included are videos for the two Marbles tracks, "Don't Hurt Yourself" and "You're Gone" (both, in regular and extended/alternate versions), as well as a short documentary on the making of the album.
