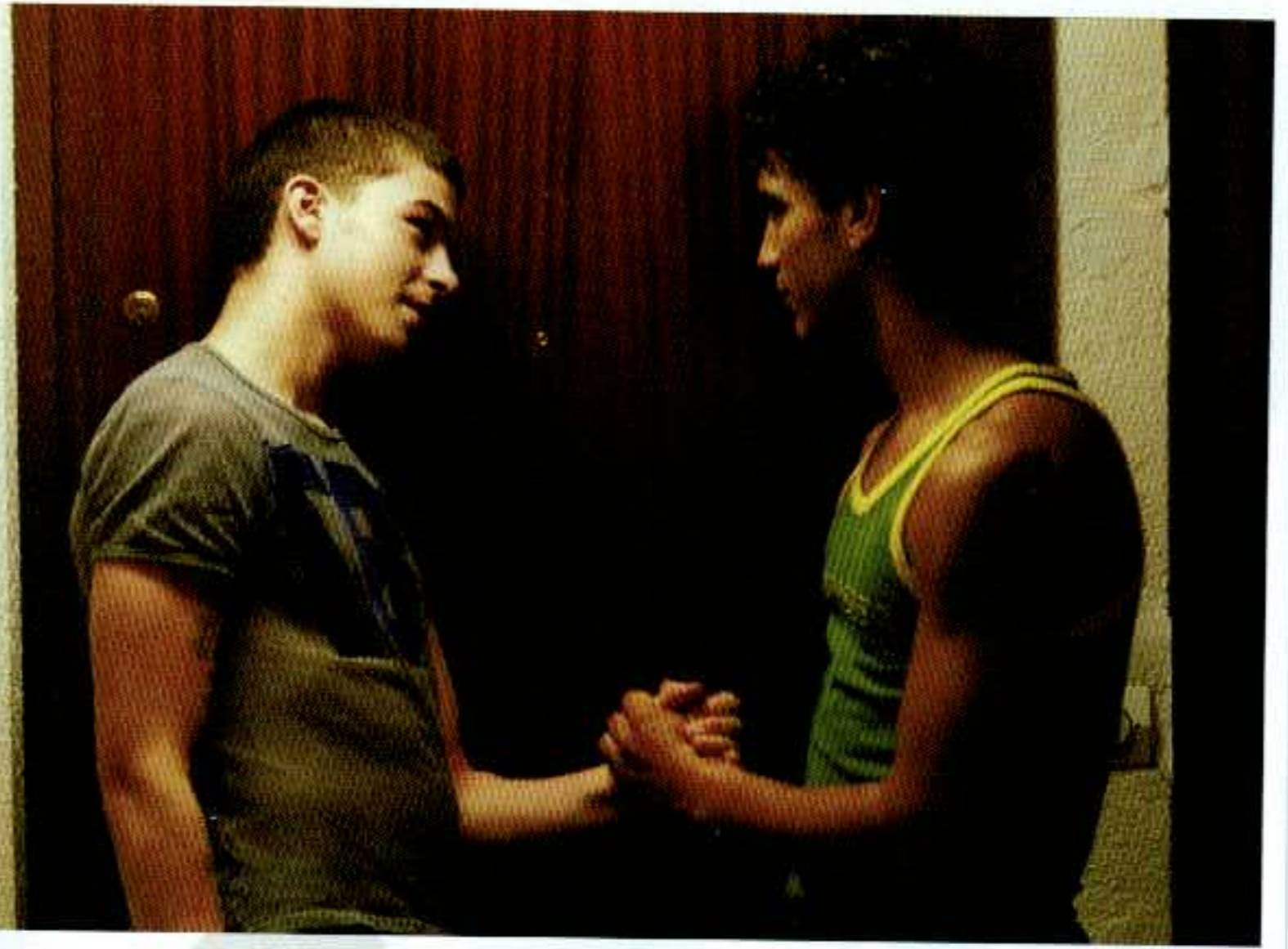


### THREE DANCING SLAVES

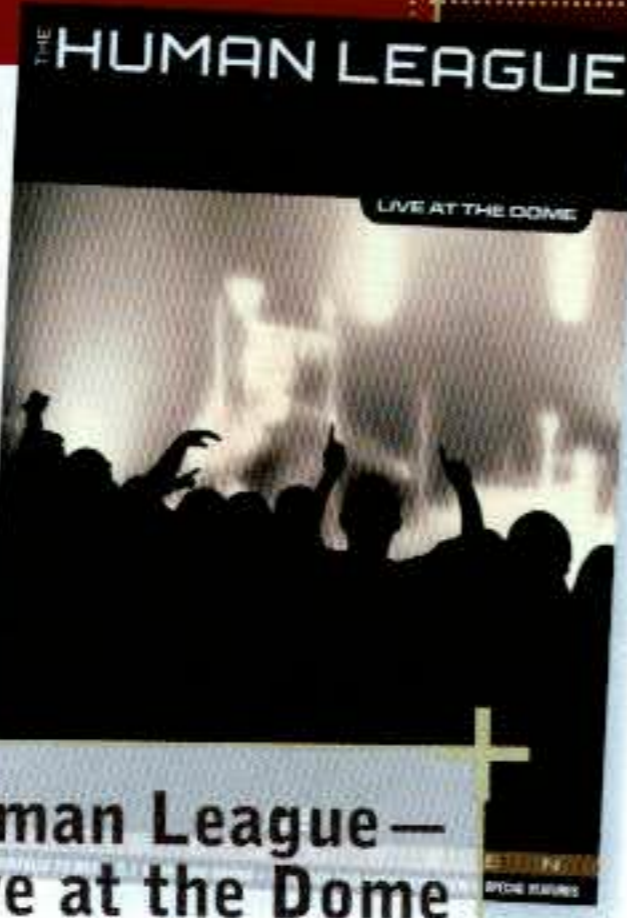

Set in France along the Swiss border, *Three Dancing Slaves* is the study of three young brothers desperately searching for emotional guidance as they face the onset of adulthood. They can't turn to their parents: their mother has recently died, and their father is distant and ineffectual. As boys they had been close to each other, and they long to maintain those childlike bonds; one scene where they revisit their childhood by sleeping together in the nude is both searingly erotic and sweetly naïve. As they become men, though, they are unable to adjust their relationships.

## THE DVD shelf

This live DVD - filmed in Brighton in December - marks the climax to their hugely successful '03 tour. It can't be called a comeback tour: media exposure of them and their music - in clever car commercials or television rockumentaries - guarantees that the Human League will never lose profile. After all their brand of synth-pop was the sound of the 1980s. "Listening to the Human League, is like listening to 1980!" These words came from David Bowie in 1979, a year or so before Jo Catherall, Susanne Sulley and the big hits all materialized. The Human League that Bowie referred to was a futuristic synth, vocals and slide-show experience, not a band in the normal sense.

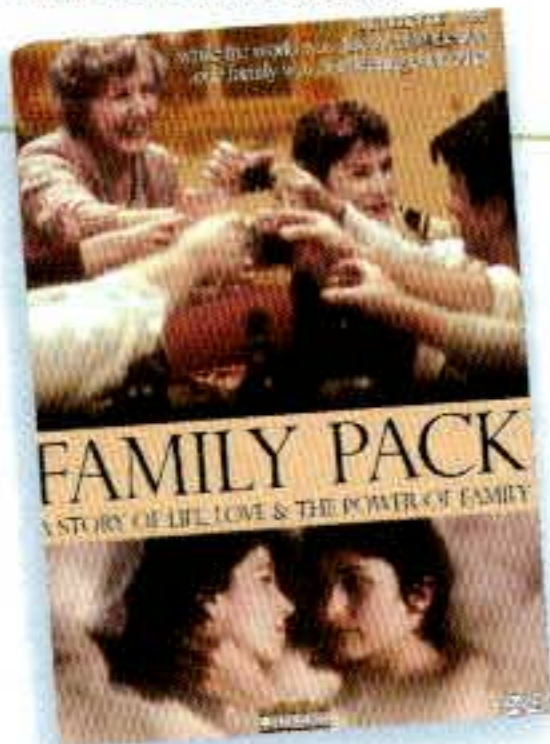
