



**THE BUTTERFLY BALL 'A FILM BY TONY KLINGER DVD'

The legendary Children's book 'The butterfly ball' was published in 1973 and successfully performed live on stage at the Royal Albert Hall on October 16, 1975, of which this DVD is the captured original performance with most of the musicians and singers whom also performed on the original album release of ROGER GLOVER. The only missing singer is RONNIE JAMES DIO, who of course sang the song everyone will remember ("Love is all"), so that was a bit of a shame, but nevertheless, the original performance on this DVD features such rock heroes like IAN GILLAN, GLENN HUGHES, DAVID COVERDALE, JOHN LAWTON and many others. 30 years later it stood the test of time and therefore this is one of those must-have DVDs in case you never saw the performance of 'The butterfly ball'. The music was a mix of lots of styles, with QUEEN and DEEP PURPLE being close comparisons at times, but actually most of the time it was far more experimental going into pop, jazz or soul directions, but also bizarre doo-wa-doop could be seen and heard.
