De Mono



Review

Poland's De Mono issue an extensive DVD with lots of bells and whistles on *Nie Wszystko Na Sprzeda*, featuring two concerts and five commercial video clips. The first is the nine-song *Paparazzi* concert (where De Mono opened for the group *INXS*) recorded live at the Leg TV studio in Cracow, 1998. The second is nine songs from Sopot in 2001. Where musical sounds from instruments (voice included) are universal, it is still hard for some English-speaking fans of American jazz and pop to relate to Polish-language singing, and this *Boz Scaggs*-styled sound would be no exception for such listeners. The song "Paparazzi" opens things up and drives nicely enough, but without words to relate to, the non-Polish speaker truly must be in the mood to find something different for – as you can imagine – the storyline is impossible to follow. The frontman, *Andrzej Krzywy*, is a better-looking version of *Elvis Costello* when he's got his variety of glasses on, a handsome man without them. He has a smooth voice on the selections, including "Kiedy Bylas Blisko Mnie," which also displays some very tasty saxophone from his bandmate *Robert Chojnacki*. The highly proficient group is allegedly "the best-selling, top Polish pop/rock band," but De Mono don't take the *ABBA* route, which is to seek new worlds to conquer by translating their compositions and gearing their message to other regions of the world. The five commercial videos are lovely but also hard to relate to for those who do not understand Polish. The biography is posted in both English and Polish and begins in 1984.
