Dwarves - "FEFU: The DVD" DVD - Generally not known as one of the more tuneful (or tasteful) punk bands, yet ranking high in the attitude sweepstakes, the legendary Dwarves here present a superb collection of clips and historical videos. It's all centered around their latest promo video clip, which is wisely (at least for retail's sake) abbreviated as 'F.E.F.U.'. Utilizing the, eh, talents of some lovely Suicide Girls, the video is an over-the-top celebration of sleaze and perversity, of naked breasts, blood, and violence. Oh, and an undulating 'little person', too. Cool stuff, and most assuredly a field day for feminists and the politically-correct. In addition to a makingof presentation, the DVD presents a series of live clips from the 80s to today, some TV interviews, and an early promo clip that's more horror/deathrock-situated than their current hardcore permutation. The live clips are fraught with riots, fights, gratuitous nudity, filth, and good old fashioned renegade rock with a capital 'ROCK'. These guys embody the outsider punk spirit far better than any of today's self-important emo or post-hardcore acts, and their reckless abandon proves a good history lesson for folks unfamiliar with the group's outre ouvre.
