

Bob Dylan: The Unauthorized Documentaries (Buy 2006)

Three disc box set of tour documentaries directed by Bob Dylan authority and impersonator Joel Gilbert. 1966 World Tour [The Home Movies] is made up of footage 8mm color film shot by the tour drummer (turned successful actor) Mickey Jones, constructed with help from director Joel Gilbert and new interviews with Jones, Charlie Daniels, Johnny Rivers and Trini Lopez. Features music by the Dylan tribute band "Highway 61 Revisited." Bob Dylan - World Tours 1966-1974 features the portraits of photographer Barry Feinstein, Dylan's official tour photographer for the 1966 and 1974 world tours, along with new footage by director Joel Gilbert interviewing friends, experts, and others to reconstruct the years between the tours. The 4-hour Rolling Thunder and The Gospel Years: A Totally Unauthorized Documentary chronicles his Rolling Thunder Revue, the tour film Renaldo and Clara, his evangelical years, and the albums recorded through the period, including his three gospel albums.
