

I'd heard about this notorious documentary years before I got the chance to see it, and it's every bit as amazing as it sounds. G.G. Allin was the lead singer of a fairly typical hardcore punk band (with songs like "Bite It You Scum"), with the exception that Allin lived his songs. During performances, he would appear naked, defecate on the floor, insert foreign objects into his bum, throw things at and fight with the audience.
